FACEBOOK FOLLOWERS

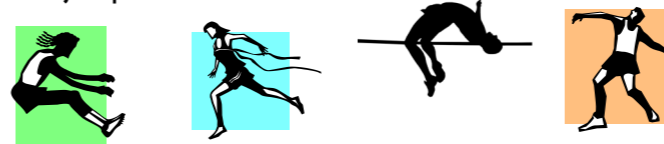
